The company was chosen not just for its raw material savings but also for its logistics optimisation. Especially for 60x120cm tiles and the 20x120cm size. As well as for the simplification of its packaging system.

"Environmental awareness is an important pillar of the company's growth strategy and this award, received for the second time, further underlines the value of our work to support sustainability over the years," explains Davide Colli, Chief Operating Officer of Ceramiche Piemme. "Today, the circular economy is able to create value if it forms part of a well structured organisational process.
